Motatau Marae Trustees	\$95,366	Cyber Whare - networking with other Northland community cyber whares to provide access to ICT and training while sharing resources with other community groups.
Ngati Wai Trust Board	\$314,328	The establishment of three ICT marae-based learning centres, that provide access and training. The marae sites are networked through the Ngatiwai Trust Board. The project also develops the Ngatiwai website to include a portal for communication between the iwi, the marae. local and geographically dispersed iwi members.
One Double Five Whare Roopu Community House	\$99,482	Cyber Whare - networking with other Northland community cyber whares to provide access to ICT and training while sharing resources with other community groups.
Otamatea Kauri and Pioneer Museum Trust	\$50,709	To digitise the historical photographic collection of Tudor Collins Bush.

Pa o te Ora Trust	\$81,957	Cyber Whare - networking with other Northland community cyber whares to provide access to ICT and training while sharing resources with other community groups.
Te Hua o Te Kawariki	\$179,550	Recording local digital stories, run digital storytelling workshops, set up Centre for digital storytelling.

Auckland War Memorial Museum	\$115,545	To add to the existing Cenotaph database, information about the NZ Service personnel who served in WW1 and to develop a web education presentation.
Carey Baptist College	\$5,000	Online database of Baptist biographies.
Clinical Trials Auckland	\$105,925	Creation of digital content to provide mobile phone based health programmes for self esteem, smoking cessation, coping skills, depression and prevention of risky behaviour (alcohol). Targeted to youth who will be involved in creating content (video messages etc).
COMET (City of Manukau Education Trust)	\$99,999	Coordinate professional development in Early Childcare Centres. Netsafe to provide training on Internet safety. Develop ICT plans for each Centre (30) in order to achieve goal of each centre having access to broadband, a digital camera and 2 computers.
Internet Safety Group Inc	\$438,000	Production of 4 episodes (5 minutes long) also available on CD. Internet and technology safety content - targeted to 2-10 year olds. Available as an educational resource.

Leadership New Zealand	\$5,000	Online leadership forum to access up to date info, share research conduct discussion sessions. Using an 'off the shelf' product, modelled on Australian programmes.
Matagi E Fa Trust	\$60,000	Community based training for Pacific People, computer software applications, hardware and multimedia presentation. Targeted to Pacific community leaders and youth at risk.
NZ TelePaediatric Society	\$75,000	Hospital to home video conferencing targeting children (with chronic and/or life threatening illness) and their carers, living in remote or non-metropolitan areas. Pilot Programme.
Royal New Zealand Foundation of the Blind	\$88,646	Development of technology to create an internet digital talking book player. Targeted to the visually impaired but could have wider benefit for others with a disability (learning etc) and non-readers. Working with a technology company who is experienced with adaptive technology.
Unitec NZ	\$245,000	Development of a website based clearing-house to store information about community & voluntary sector research. It is intended to provide researchers access to community organisations to conduct research as well as tangata whenua and community organisation access to research and/or researchers.
University of Auckland	\$95,200	3D scanning and manipulation of cultural artefacts, production of interactive educational programme, upskill partner in digital imaging.

2020 Communications Trust Waikato	\$37,082	Create increased functionality to WebGuide (targeted to community organisations to improve ability to use the internet). Also to promote the guide via sending hardcopies of the guide to organisations.
Artmakers Community Artists Trust	\$85,423	Develop a database of digital stories, offering workshops to community groups to develop their skills and to create the stories.
NZ Institute of Rural Health	\$96,656	Online training for rural health workers. Providing training on using ICT and health targeted training (esp First responder content). This will be piloted with 4 organisations then a NZ roll-out is anticipated.
The Hauraki Maori Trust Board	\$206,500	Utilising 'Greenstone' software, a digital library of archive recordings, videos and documents will be created. A user manual targeted for community group in the use of the software will be produced and workshops will also be delivered.
Volunteering Waikato	\$9,891	Professional development training (volunteer best practice etc) recorded on CD Rom - for community groups who work with volunteers.
Waikato Institute of Technology Culture On-Line	\$50,000	Create a series of online, interactive sessions exploring different cultures, teach basic phrases and provide tips for intercultural communication.

Eltham Community Care Inc	\$169,759	To extend the current Computers in Homes to a further 100 families, aims to increase its reach to include 10 'iwi' families, 15 families who are ICT challenged as well as the school families.
Puke Ariki - New Plymouth District Council	\$95,600	To create an interactive website targeted for school children and local iwi to create content about Mt Taranaki using multimedia tools. Workshops will be delivered and a short film will also be produced.

Horowhenua Library Trust	\$90,833	Online Digital Library for cultural and historical content - using Greenstone and Koha (international award winning open source library system). Training of SeniorNet volunteers to upload content.

Manawatu-Wanganui Regional Council Inc	\$85,133	Create a self-contained 'Green Rig' that will promote a hands-on learning approach to environmental education and promote the use of technology in the rural sector.

National Library of NZ	\$544,397	Pilot of the 'Peoples Network' in at least 10 libraries. The Peoples Network provides people with free access to the internet, email and word processing applications. The project will also create a portal designed to access relevant New Zealand content. Libraries will provide on-site assistance to users.
Pandemonic Operations Trust	\$49,260	Develop existing upstage software to allow communities to develop their own content (performances, art and stories).
Porirua City Council	\$75,400	Asset Map (Business, community and voluntary sector; ICT infrastructure and Learning centres; awareness raising; GIS). Using digital storytelling as part of method
Porirua Pacific Islands Forum	\$194,797	ICT learning centre - expansion to include training component.
SOUNZ, the Centre for NZ Music	\$468,973	Development of data model software for the cataloguing of music and to digitise the collection of content.
Te Whakaruruhau O Nga Reo Irirangi Maori	\$82,039	Digitisation of 'nationally significant' radio recording of iwi radio recordings. The content is historical recordings of Kuia and Kaumatua - korero of local history, whakapapa, hui and events. Recordings contain different dialect and kupu (words) which have changed over the years.

Upper Hutt City Council	\$52,925	Community ICT Learning centre to go alongside the community centre in Timberlea.
Wellington Access Broadcasting Society	\$73,147	Online digital broadcasting for three community radio stations. Training community content providers. Utilising existing software (as tested by Wgtn Access radio).

Balance NZ - Bipolar & Depression Network	\$81,406	To increase functionality of website to enable better access to information (incorporating more regional groups), host peer support forums and run training for consumers (people with mental health issues). Particular advantage in using ICT as remaining anonymous avoids stigma often associated with mental health.
Canterbury Pasifika Limited	\$142,266	ICT Audit of local Pasifika communities, creating multilingual e-learning centre and digital Pasifika content and online communities
CORE Education Limited	\$40,422	ICT needs assessment for Muslim community.
Mediascape NZ Broadcasting School CPIT	\$51,112	Web based clearing house for NZ Media information and research managed by the NZ Broadcasting School.
Mindspace Solutions Ltd	\$39,275	Develop ARScope (binoculars to view virtual content). Content will be relevant to site of ARScopes
NZ Spinal Trust	\$30,000	Create an open access, interactive online educational curriculum about spinal injury. Wide anticipated use for those with SCI, their families and providers.

Otago Museum	\$42,499	Develop interactive games targeted to 8-14year olds, learn about ICT systems and structures through the online forum. Aims to engage target group in science and technology through ICT.
Otago Polytechnic	\$304,000	To develop 3D games based on Maori history and stories. Training modules (games-based digital storytelling) will be established as part of the project.

Westland Rural Education Activities Programme Inc	\$157,420	To Extend the Computers in Homes programme to 100 families. Intends to extend to rurally isolated areas, targeting socially and geographically isolated.
West Coast Development Trust	\$150,855	4 Projects, ICT needs assessment, Community Workshops, After school and holiday programmes, Boot camps (building computers).
